

## March 16, 2021 Vaccine Roll-Out Communication to Child Care Providers

Thank you for your commitment to your health and safety, and to the health and safety of the families you serve.

All Child Care Providers are eligible, based on State guidelines (grouped under Phase 1B sector population), to now receive the vaccine, as supply allows. The San Joaquin County Office of Emergency Services, SJ Ready [Vaccine Information | COVID-19 | Events | SJReady.org](#) has listed that Child Care Providers are now being vaccinated, as supply allows.

### To find a vaccine appointment, FRRC recommends the following:

- 1) If you are a Child Care Provider in San Joaquin County, and are interested in receiving a COVID-19 vaccination, visit: <https://sjready.org/events/covid19/vaccines.html#clinics> . There you will be able to schedule an appointment for a future vaccine event. Please note: vaccination appointments are required and appointment slots fill up quickly. You may experience that vaccine appointments are already filled for some vaccine events. Please continue to look for another vaccine event with an open time slot. You will also see on the [www.SJReady.org](http://www.SJReady.org) site, a listing of approved vaccine providers in San Joaquin County such as Safeway, CVS, and Walgreens, with web links for you to schedule an appointment.
- 2) You may also visit [www.myturn.ca.gov](http://www.myturn.ca.gov) to register for an appointment. Select “Education and childcare” in in the dropdown menu when selecting the business/industry you work when confirming your eligibility on this site.
- 3) FRRC also encourages you to call 2-1-1 if you are in need of help in registering for a vaccine appointment. Please note: you may be asked to leave a message on the 211 answering service. Please leave a message and a 211 Call Specialist will return your call.

At your vaccination appointment, you may be asked to produce documents proving that you are a Child Care Provider in San Joaquin County. Please bring to your appointment a pay-stub, licensing documentation, or any other information showing that you provide care for children.

FRRC urges you to get vaccinated when your turn becomes available. Anyone in an eligible group, needing help in registering for a vaccine appointment, please call 2-1-1. There are many vaccine providers in the area who are taking appointments, but again, supply is limited. Please check your email to receive updates on future Child Care Provider Vaccination events in San Joaquin County.

Please continue to check your emails from Family Resource & Referral Center, as we are in constant communication with providers on the vaccination rollout. We encourage you to call 211 for your COVID-19 questions. FRRC is doing everything in its control to ensure Child Care Providers, our frontline heroes, receive the vaccine and are alerted about vaccination opportunities. This is a fluid situation, with information changing quickly. We appreciate your patience and hope that in the near future there will be an increase in vaccine supply.
